- How to inspect the Linux equivalent of job \$STDLISTs
- A review of production processes (such as printing Accounts Payable and Payroll checks)
- How to manage nightly processes, such as ACTKLD, BALFIX and VENKLD
- A review of QSS/OASIS automated tasks (dealing with \$STDLISTs, log files, etc.)
- How to install QSS/OASIS Version "L" releases
